



TRANSFER OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

New transfer students will be selected each year to receive a \$3000 per year scholarship for up to three years. Applicants must be transfer students from other colleges who will be sophomores or juniors upon enrollment at Gonzaga (minimum of 46 quarter or 31 semester credits earned at the time of application) and intend to pursue a Bachelor of Arts, Sciences, Business Administration or Education degree full-time.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- Submit a Federal Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) for the upcoming academic year and be sure to list Gonzaga as one of your choices (#003778). FAFSA applications are available from the Financial Aid Office on on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- Apply for admission to Gonzaga University by March 1 for fall or November 1 for spring. Applications are available from the Office of Admission or on-line at: <http://www.gonzaga.edu/Admissions/Undergraduate-Admissions/Prospective-Students/Transfer-Students/default.asp>
- Complete all requirements on the reverse side of this form, including essay, by April 1 for fall or November 15 for spring

- Enroll over consecutive years (without transferring to another institution)
- Complete 12 or more credits each term
- Maintain “good academic standing,” as defined in the current University Catalogue
