Awarded to Outstanding High School Graduates Who Enroll in the School of Business at Gonzaga University

\$10,000 over four years

Background:

Professor Daniel Brajcich taught in the accounting department of the School of Business at Gonzaga University for over 50 years. He established a flagship program whose graduates head corporations, CPA firms, and universities. In 1987, grateful alumni founded the Daniel Brajcich Scholarship Fund to assist students interested in pursuing a business degree at Gonzaga University.

Scholarships:

The Scholarship Fund is offering financial assistance of **\$2,500 per year, renewable for four years**, to outstanding students who demonstrate financial need and enroll in the School of Business during their freshman year at Gonzaga. Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain good academic standing, a 2.75 GPA, and full-time status in the School of Business.

Application Process Requirements:

- Complete the Application for Admission to Gonzaga University
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by February 1
- Complete the attached Daniel G. Brajcich Scholarship Application
- Submit an essay of no more than 700 words that describes your career goals and interests
- Intend to enroll in the School of Business at Gonzaga University
