### CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION:

- May be either a freshman or transfer student.
- Enrolled in a federal and/or state recognized tribe.
- Minimum GPA of 3.1 or higher for high school applicants.
- Transfer students should have at least one academic year of college-level work completed with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Complete and submit the Application for Admission to Gonzaga University by February 1.
- Complete the Charlotte Y. Martin Native American Scholarship Application, to include required essays, by February 1.
- Provide proof of tribal enrollment.

**POSTMARKED DEADLINE FOR COMPLETED APPLICATIONS IS FEBRUARY 1**

The Charlotte Y. Martin Native American Scholarship was established by the Charlotte Y. Martin Foundation at Gonzaga University to honor outstanding Native American students seeking to pursue their college degree at Gonzaga.
