Gonzaga University Graduate School of Business

Overview

Scholarships in the Graduate School of Business provide financial assistance to students of high promise who demonstrate significant potential to benefit from graduate education. The award is divided equally between the fall and spring semesters.

Eligibility

You must be admitted into the MBA or MAcc/MSTax program by July 1st. If you have applied, but have not yet been accepted to your program, you are ineligible for this scholarship. Additionally, you must demonstrate financial need and be in good academic standing.

Application Procedure

Submit the following documents **by July 1** to the Graduate School of Business Office (Jepson 261) or via email to **ferneym@gonzaga.edu**:

1. Application
2. Cover letter
3. **Current** resumé
4. Unofficial graduate transcripts (if a continuing graduate student)
5. Two letters of recommendation: if employed, one letter should be from your employer*
6. GMAT information (unofficial copy of score is acceptable)*

***Please note: For 5-6 we will use the documentation from your MBA or MAcc application unless we receive alternative documents.**
