## 2019 – 2020 Academic Year Data Report

The Resolution Center for Student Conduct and Conflict (The RC) is responsible for reviewing alleged violations of the Student Code of Conduct and for coordinating process to resolve referred allegations. This report reflects data of reports received by The RC during the time period of **August 15, 2019 and May 15, 2020**. This report was generated on May 21, 2020, which may cause some reports to still be in process and considered pending.

Please note, during the Spring 2020 semester, Gonzaga University experienced significant operational changes related to the COVID-19 Pandemic, including the closure of most residential facilities and transition to distance education. These operational changes impacted the number and type of reports and/or conduct proceedings managed by the Resolution Center.

### Referrals

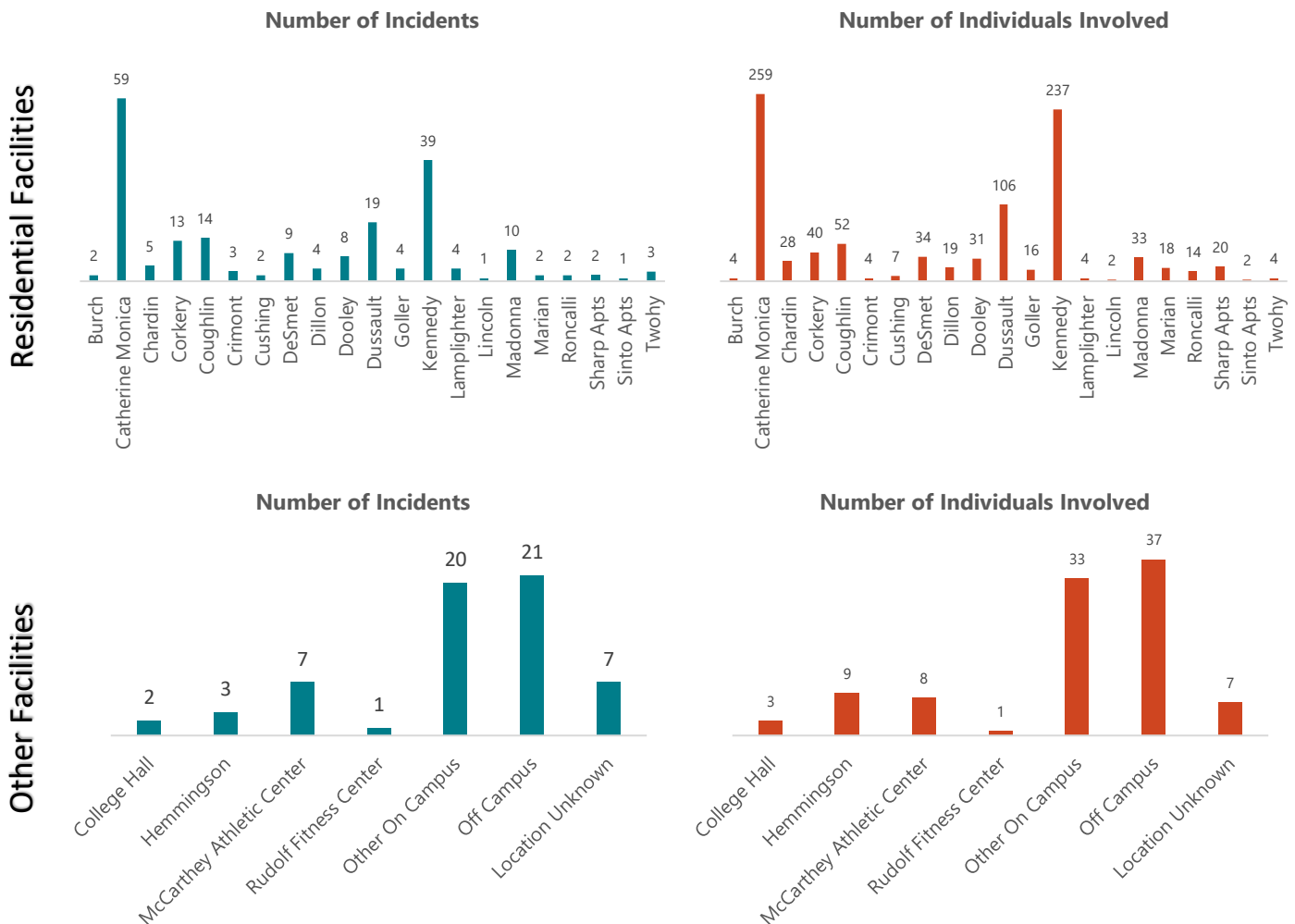
The RC receives reports of alleged misconduct and complaints against a student from a variety of sources, including but not limited to:

These reports are reviewed by staff in the Resolution Center to determine if there is sufficient information that a violation of the Student Code of Conduct may have occurred.

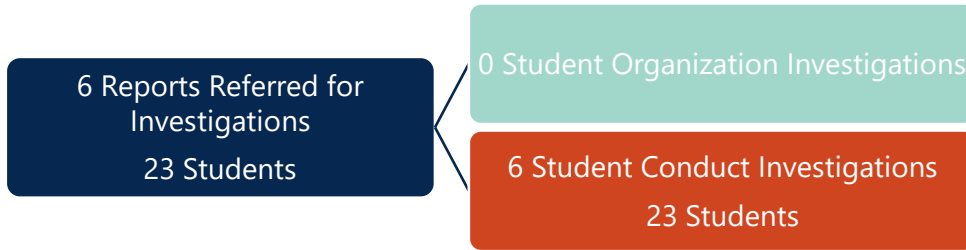

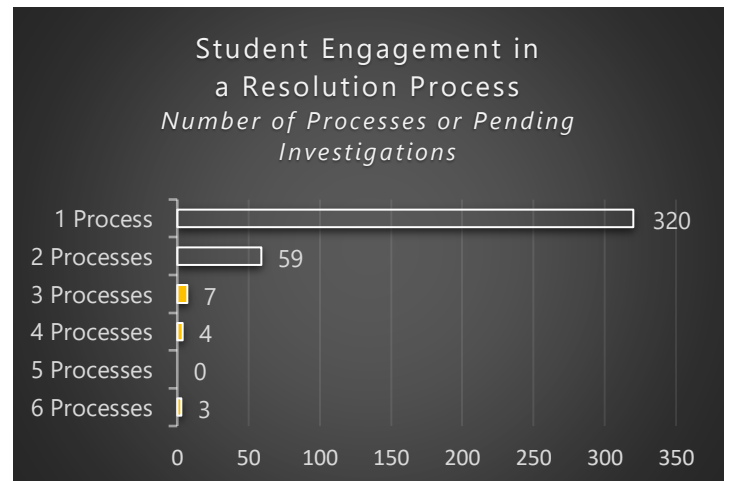
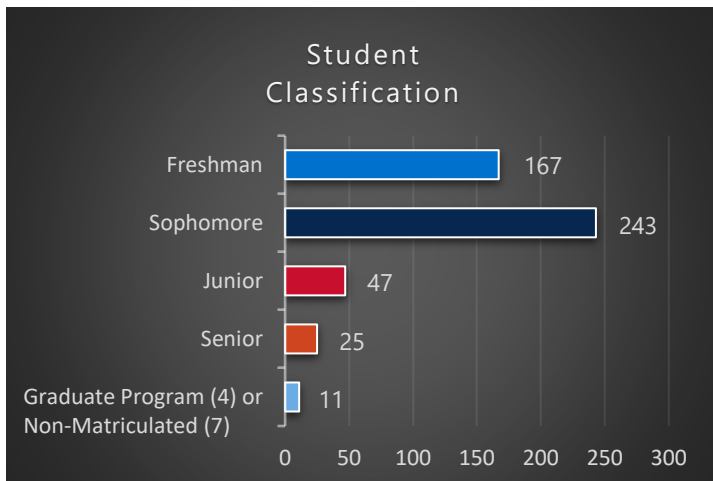
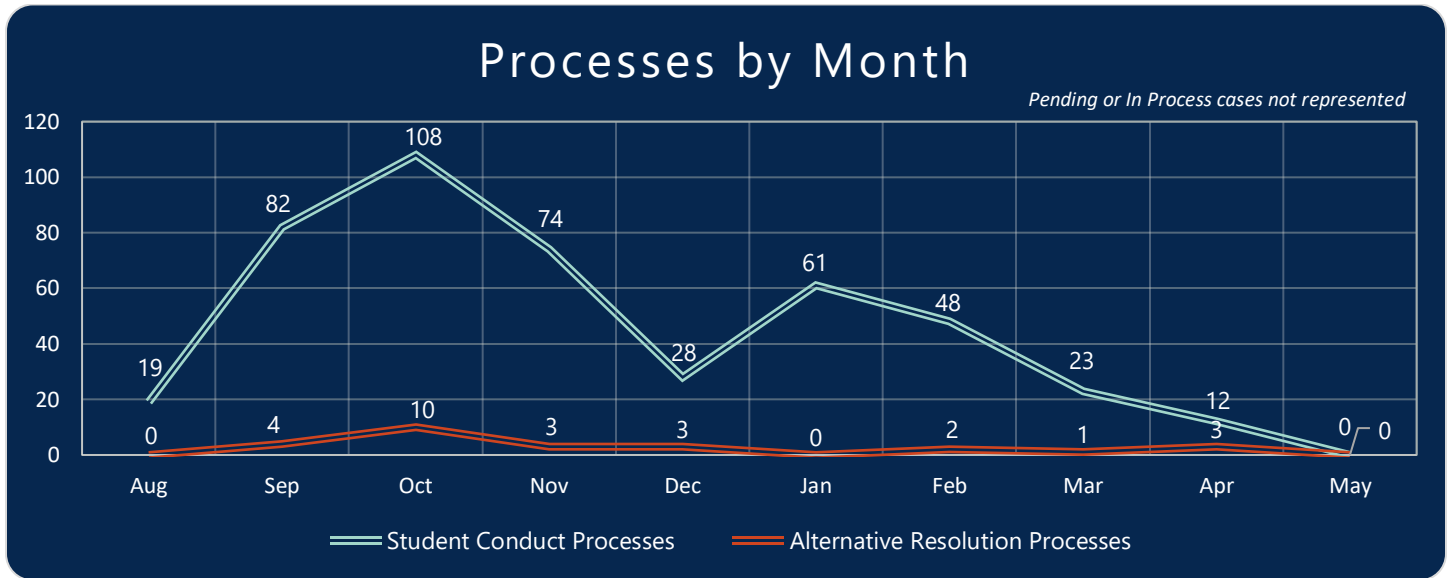
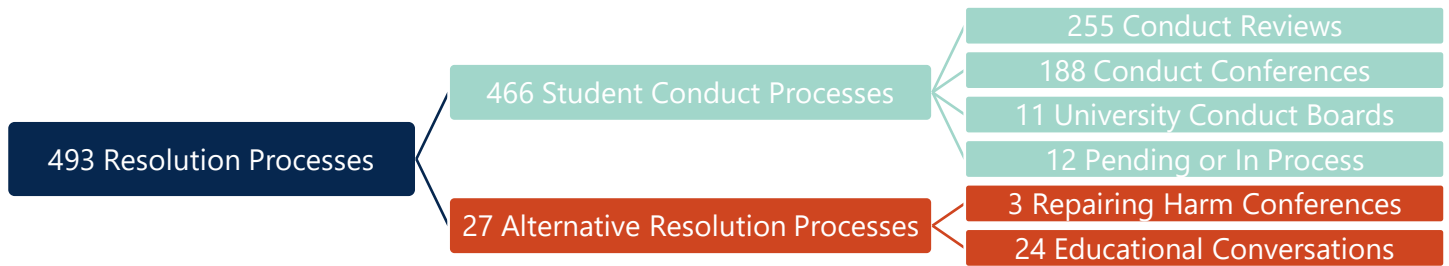
### Investigation
